## HOME CARE

### DIABETES MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

The patient may be post hospitalization or referred for home health intervention from a physician's office. The patient must be homebound, have an exacerbation of an existing illness or onset of a new disease process.

#### **Acute Complications**

- Uncontrolled diabetes making outpatient services inappropriate
- Profound hypoglycemia & hyperglycemia

#### **Chronic Complications**

- Renal failure
- Peripheral vascular disease with ulcerations
- Wound care
- Assessment and treatment of autonomic/sensory complications

#### **Post-Operative Care**

- Pancreatectomy
- Amputation
- Kidney/pancreas transplantation
- Cardiovascular surgery

#### **Infections**

- Osteomyelitis
- Local or systemic infection requiring IV therapy intervention
